

SIERRA NEVADA COMMUNITY SAILING, INC. DOCKAGE RENTAL AGREEMENT

1. The Dock Master is delegated by the Sierra Nevada Community Sailing, Inc. (hereinafter SNCS) Board of Trustees to have authority over the day-to- day operation of the marina and must be obeyed at all times. This includes authority to request members to leave the marina. **Refusal to comply with the marina rules, or requests made by the Dock Master, may result in loss of assigned dockage and/or SNCS membership.**
2. The SNCS docks are for the use of SNCS members and their guests. A member must accompany guests at all times and shall be held responsible for any infraction of SNCS rules or damages to SNCS property by their guests.
3. For the safety of all, no running, swimming, or water fights are allowed in the dock area. Bicycles are not allowed on any piers or floating dock walkways. Parents will be responsible for their children's compliance with marina rules.
4. Agreements for seasonal dock rentals or dry storage are boat specific. The Dock Master prior to being placed in the assigned slip or dry storage space must approve the size and condition of all boats. Boats placed in both wet dockage and dry storage must be registered in the name of the renter of the dockage or storage. Renter must show proof of current registration and of liability insurance.
5. Any member assigned a dock slip, who will temporarily not be using their slip, such as having their boat out of the slip for repair, is requested to advise the Dock Master that boat is being repaired.
6. Each dock renter will be responsible for the maintenance, cleaning and repair for his/her personal property. If your boat is secured with a lock, a spare key must be given to the Dock Master. Never drive nails or screws into docks or frame.
7. It is expressly agreed that SNCS is not responsible in any manner whatsoever, for the safe keeping or condition of owner's boat; that there is no duty for SNCS to keep owner's boat under surveillance or in repair; that SNCS shall not be liable to the owner or to any person for damage to or loss of the owner's craft, its gear, tackle, equipment, or other property of the owner or owner's guests brought onto the SNCS premises by anyone, from any cause whatsoever. Should SNCS, its members, employees or others, voluntarily go to the rescue of the vessel, or take any action or lack of action, with respect to the vessel's safekeeping or custody, which said actions owner hereby authorizes and invites, then in consideration thereof all such parties so assisting the vessel are hereby expressly released by the owner of and from any and all claims for malfeasance or nonfeasance with respect to the vessel or its gear, tackle or equipment or other property of the owner upon SNCS' premises.
8. Complaints or suggestions should be presented in writing to the Dock Master.
